Rules & Requirements

Obstacle Course • Chair Bowling • Chair Shotput

An Office Chair Challenge Team consists of two people and one office chair

Pit boss is the source of propulsion for the course, holds the life of the rider in their hands, and is mainly responsible for making sure there are no casualties.

The rider is the brave soul that sits in the chair for the extent of the race.

Office Chair Requirements:

- Must have at least three wheels or casters
- Must have a swivel base
- Must have been used for at least one day (8 hours) in your office before race day
- Modification is allowed and encouraged!

Protective Gear

- All team members are required to wear a helmet. All helmets must be certified by an Office Chair Challenge Official at check in.
- Other protective gear is encouraged as the Office Chair Challenge is a dangerous sport.
- Team uniforms are encouraged among all team members.

HOW TO WIN - OBSTACLE COURSE

Rule #1

- Each competitor must have his or her rear firmly planted in the seat of the chair at all times. Locomotion may be provided in any manner (with the exception of other people) so long as this rule is observed.
- If the chair tips over, the competitor must right the chair and sit back down in it before continuing (time penalty applies).

Rule #2

- The rider may not intentionally interfere with another chair. If a rider intentionally interferes with another rider the team will be disqualified.
- Enforcement of rules will be handled by a certified Office Chair Challenge Official and will not be subject to appeal or public trial.
- The winner is determined by a point system based on each challenge.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the winners of each challenge, as well as the top three point leaders in the tournament.

In addition prizes will also be awarded for:

- The team with the most team spirit
- The most creative chair
